This should serve as a guide to getting your site set up and started. Specific due dates and a grading rubric will be distributed at a later time. Additional items will also be added before your portfolio is graded.

Home Page

- Photo of you or appropriate image (image should relate to our school, our department, or academics)
- Paragraph or a few sentences welcoming viewers and a description of the purpose of you site.

About Me Page

- Should include paragraphs about you. Include your hobbies, likes, dislikes, goals for the future, etc.
- You may want to incorporate a photo gallery or slide show on this page.

Academics

- Paragraph about academics, requirements to graduate
- Link to graduation requirements

Academic Page of Your Choice 1 (include paragraph, project/class pictures, student work, etc.)

Academic Page of Your Choice 2 (include paragraph, project/class pictures, student work, etc.)

<u>Arts</u>

- Description of our school and the Communication Arts department
- Link to or embed Program of Study, links to school web pages, arts web page, audition requirements

Audio & Video Technology & Film

- Description of the course (remember you can use our program of study)
- o Image of you filming or editing in film class
- Links to student work that corresponds to course: links to videos, scripts, story boards, portfolio docs
- Snap shots of videos you've created, links to reflection about projects

Introduction to Business & Technology

- Description of course and links to student work from IBT
- Link to IBT blogs (Digital Citizenship & Business Concepts)

Film & Media Festival

- o Paragraph about the film & media festival, include last year's poster design
- o Picture from last year's event (we can update this after this year's event)

Web Tools

- List and describe at least <u>five</u> Web Tools that can be used in your classes (arts or academics) Examples include: Khan Academy, Edmodo, Google Drive, Symbaloo, etc. You can use screen shots of the sites or their logos.
- Link to the web tools you select. (You must include descriptions of the sites and how they are used)

Blogs

- Exploring Digital Citizenship (posts written during class or for homework after discussing different digital citizenship topics)
- Business Concepts (posts written during class or for homework after discussing different business concepts)

Additional Requirements & Things to Consider:

- You are required to have another page on your site. It can be and FBLA page, community involvement, Athletics, hobbies, etc. You can decide what the page is about and where it is located.
- Your resume should be included someone where on the site. Make sure to update it frequently.
- Blogs-You must include the two Blogs we discussed, more guidelines coming soon. (remember, you will need to set your blogs up differently if you are not publishing it)
- Include at least one "gallery" or "slide show" within your site.
- Include a link to at least one other site like twitter, facebook, pinterest, etc.
- Include a link to least on video created in Beringson's class this year.
- Include appropriate images when necessary but be careful about copyright.
